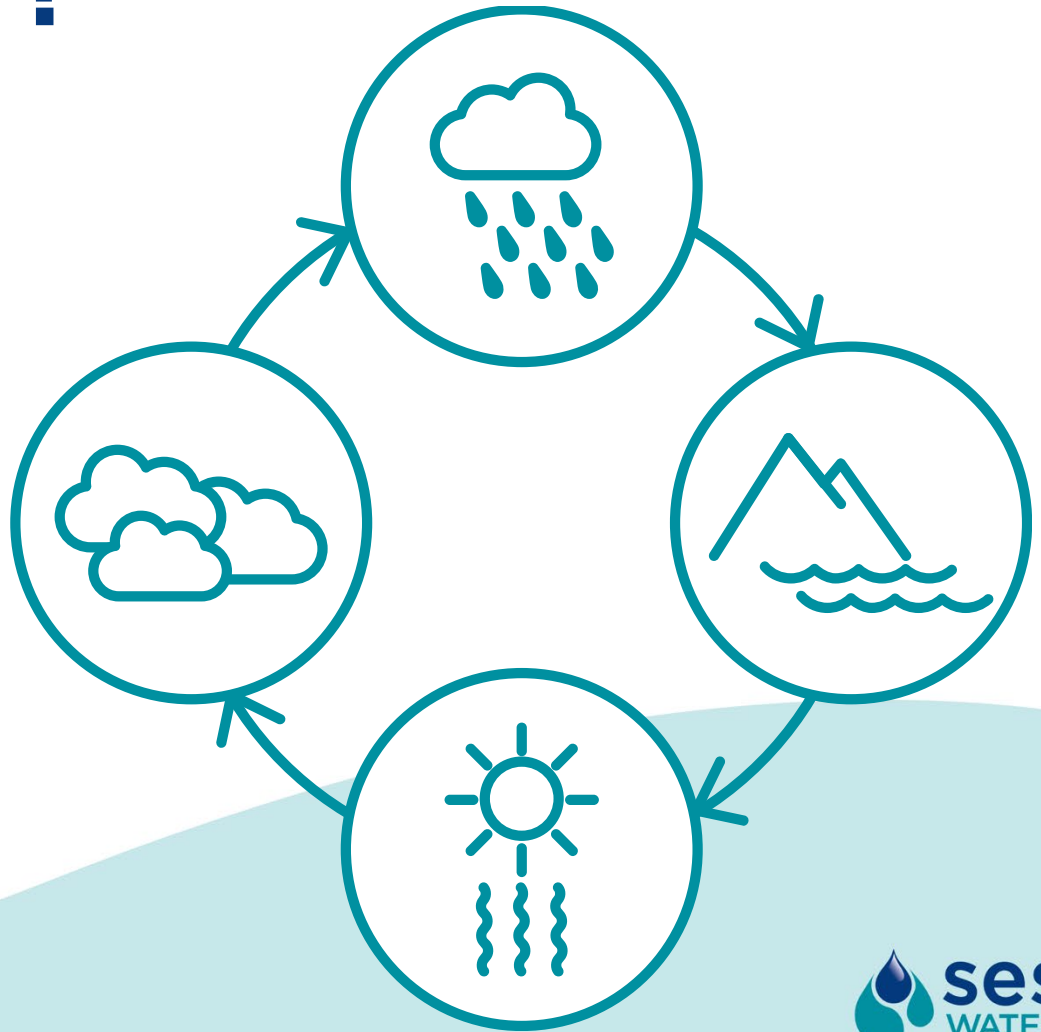

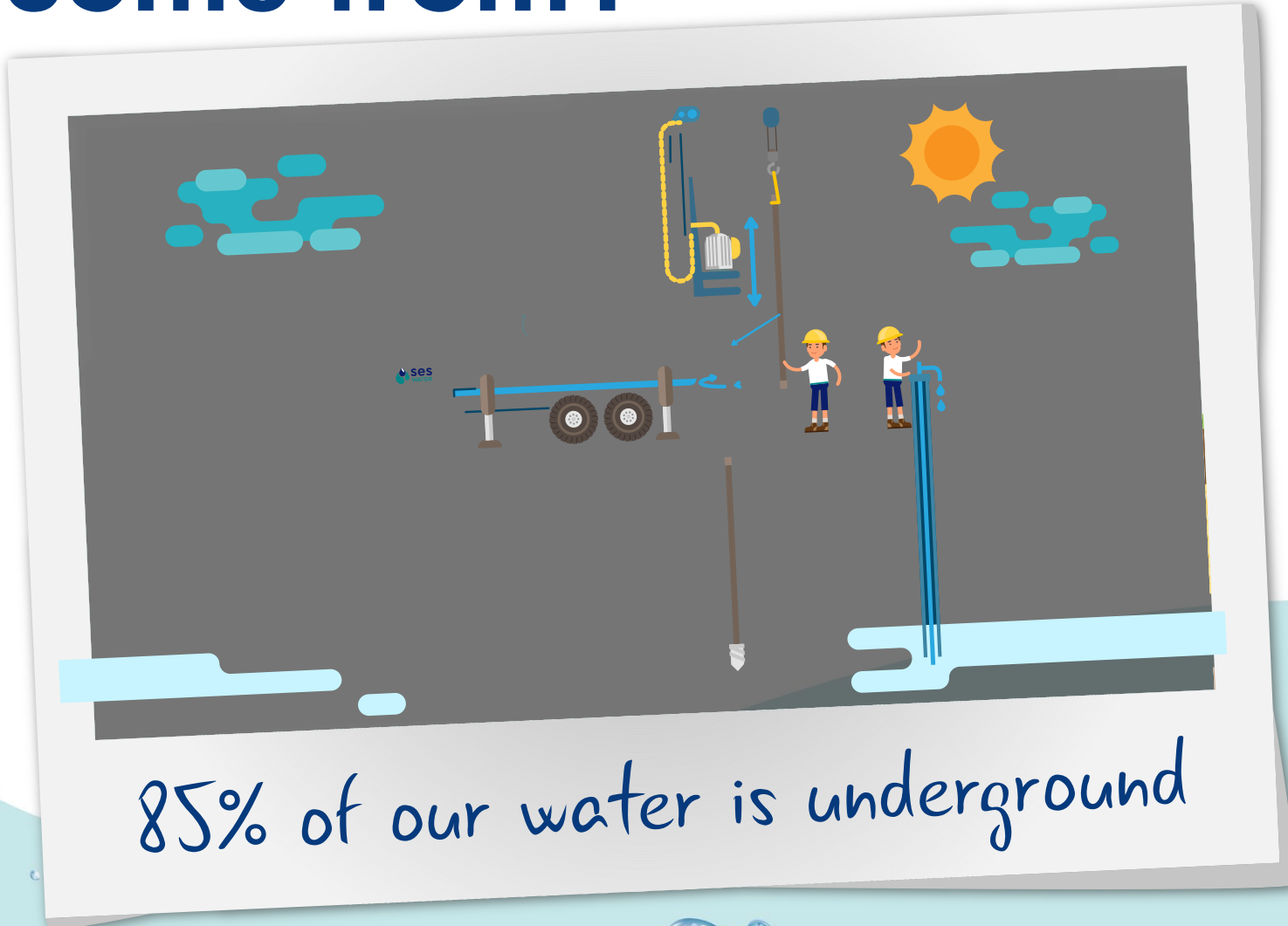

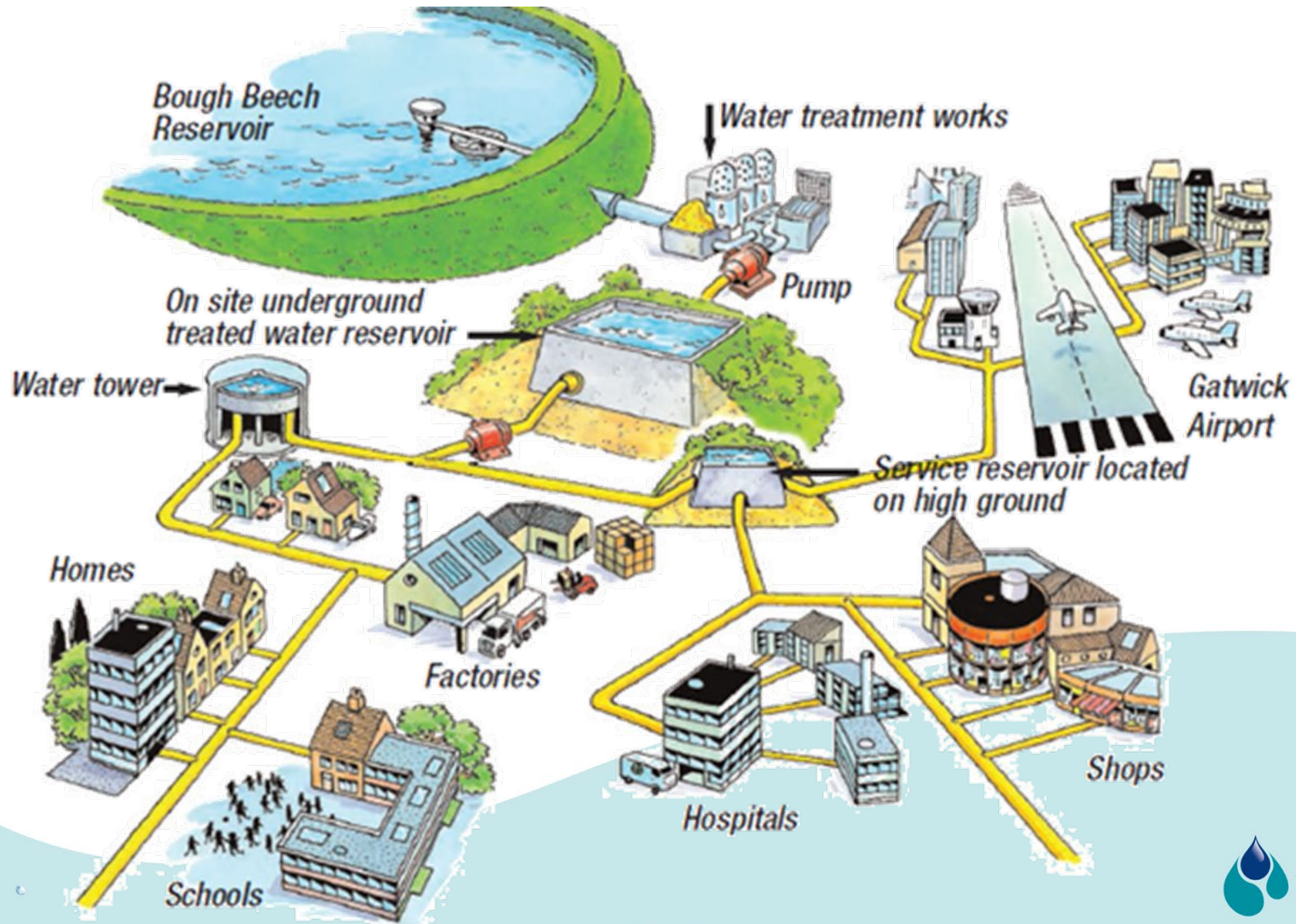


15% is from our reservoir at Bough Beech

We also wear protective clothing.

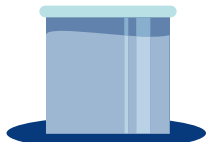

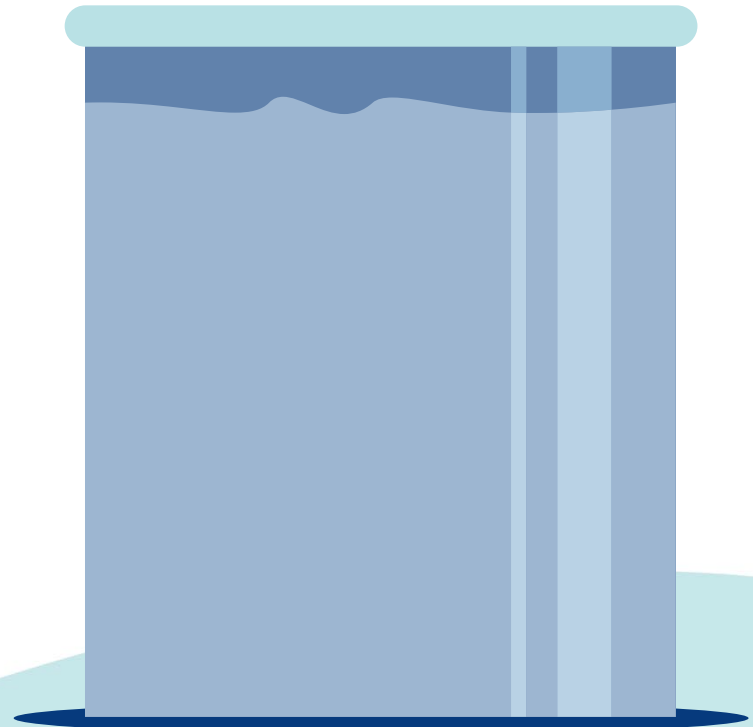

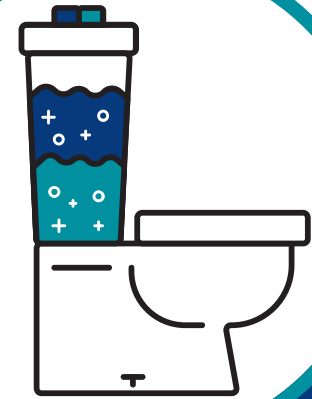
